

## Pembroke Regional Hospital Foundation Announces Launch of Catch the Ace 2.0!

**(Pembroke)** The Pembroke Regional Hospital Foundation (PRHF) is excited to announce the launch of *Catch the Ace* 2.0! This will be the second *Catch the Ace* Lottery for the PRHF. Ticket sales open online Wednesday, February 17<sup>th</sup> at 10am at <u>www.prhcatchtheace.ca</u>.

"We are thrilled with the community support for the first *Catch the Ace* lottery which brought in an amazing \$187,000 for the PRHF *Cancer Care Campaign* and are so excited to do it again for such an important cause. This is truly about community helping community," said the Foundation's Executive Director Roger Martin.

*Catch the Ace* 2.0 will look relatively the same as the last and will feature a guaranteed weekly prize and a progressive jackpot that goes to the winner who catches the Ace of Spades. Ticket prices are as follows: 3/\$5; 10/\$10 and 40/\$20, giving you the chance to win both the weekly prize and the progressive jackpot, with 50% of ticket sales going to the PRHF *Cancer Care Campaign*, and our highest priority needs! One change to note is the timing of the draws. Ticket sales will open online on Wednesday each week at 10am and ticket sales will close each week on Tuesday at 11:59pm. Weekly winners will be announced Wednesday mornings at 10am live on Facebook.

The drive-thru ticket kiosk located at 775 Pembroke Street East will reopen on Monday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>, offering a cash purchase option. The hours of operation will be as follows; Mondays 9am – 6pm, Tuesdays 9:30am – 6pm and Saturdays 10am – 2pm.

"Our volunteers are ready to go and excited for this next round to start. We thank them so much for the time they dedicate to supporting our hospital. We will also be announcing two new ticket purchase locations in the near future, one in Petawawa and one in the west end of Pembroke," said Leigh Costello, Community Fundraising Specialist for the Foundation.
