SUBJECT: Temporary Retention Incentive for Nurses Program

Background

On March 7, 2022, the Ministry of Health announced funding for the Temporary Retention Incentive for Nurses (the “TRIN Program”) as part of the Government’s ongoing response to COVID-19 and health system recovery.

The TRIN Program is part of a larger initiative focused on nurses that include significant investments by the Ministry of Health, Ministry of Solicitor General, Ministry of Children, Community and Social Services, and Ministry for Seniors Affairs and Accessibility to support the maintenance of a high-quality workforce and to reduce attrition during this critical period.

What do I need to do to get the TRIN payments?

If you are a single-employer employee, and you do not have employment at another healthcare facility other than at Pembroke Regional Hospital, then you don’t need to do anything.

If you work at another employer in addition to PRH, and if you are not Full-time, you will need to review and complete the attestation documents and forms. The attestation form for employees who work at multiple locations needs to be submitted to payroll@pemreghos.org by June 10, 2022.
