## WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW & DO

### Prior to June 18th

- Prior to the date of the password change, you should have received an email from The Ottawa Hospital from [itlogonid@toh.ca](mailto:itlogonid@toh.ca) with your temporary password for Outlook 365 email.
- **Save this password in a safe place, you will need it on the day of the update.**

### Starting on Sunday June 18th @12pm

**Note: Passwords cannot be changed prior to the scheduled date/time**

- Go into your regular email using the temporary password provided by TOH.
- Follow the link in the email to update to your new **15-character** password.
  - In addition to outlook, this will change your password for: Teams, SharePoint, OneDrive (they are all the same login)
  -

### Password Tips

- Password must contain at least 15 characters.
  - Password must contain the following: a. At least 1 uppercase character (A through Z)
  - At least 1 lowercase character (a through z)
  - At least 1 numerical digit (0 through 9)
  - At least 1 non-alphanumeric digit (~!@#\$%^&\*\_-+= ' \(){}[]:;'"<>,.?/)

3. Password must not include all or any part of the user's first/last names or username.

4. Controls are in place to prevent commonly breached passwords and prevent the use of popular password words such as the month, date, city, and others.

## **IMPORTANT NOTES**

- Citrix and Imprivata are not affected by this change.
- PRH I.T. has a copy of your temporary password should it be required.

## **UPDATING ALL YOUR PASSWORDS TO MATCH ONCE YOUR NEW EMAIL IS WORKING**

- Update your PRH Active Directory (computer) password to match your new 15-character password.
  - This is your Citrix password.
  - By updating this, you will ensure all your PRH passwords (Citrix, Computer) are the same to avoid confusion.
  - Go to any PRH computer and hit CTRL+ALT+DELETE then choose change password.
  - In one year when you are asked to update your Microsoft 365 password, you will need to do this again.
